## LATEST COVID-19 UPDATES:

- **Testing in the Derbyshire Dales**

Between 18 April 2022 and 24 April 2022, there have been 2,873 tests. This shows a decrease of -27.8% compared to the previous 7 days.

- **Cases in Derbyshire Dales**

Between 19 April 2022 and 25 April 2022, 254 people had a confirmed positive test result. This shows an increase of 104.8% compared to the previous 7 days.

- **Vaccinations in Derbyshire Dales**

61,549 people given a first dose by the end of 24 April 2022.  
59,707 people given a second dose by the end of 24 April 2022.  
51,997 given a booster/third dose by the end of 24 April 2022.

- **Healthcare in Chesterfield Royal Hospital NHS Foundation Trust**

Between 11 April 2022 and 17 April 2022, 60 went into hospital with coronavirus. This shows a decrease of -6.2% compared to the previous 7 days. There were 44 patients in hospital with coronavirus on 19 April 2022.

- **Deaths in Derbyshire Dales**

Between 19 April 2022 and 25 April 2022, there have been 3 deaths within 28 days of a positive coronavirus test. This shows no change compared to the previous 7 days.

More than one in ten eligible children under the age of five in England haven't had the MMR vaccine or are only partially vaccinated. This leaves these children unprotected and increases the risk of measles outbreaks occurring in nurseries and schools. We are reminding parents and guardians to ensure their children are protected by taking up two doses of the MMR vaccine at the right time.

Since the start of the COVID-19 pandemic in March 2020, there has been a significant drop in the number of parents and carers getting their children vaccinated against MMR and taking up other childhood vaccines. Read more [here](#).
